FERN TREE GULLY SHIRE CO. NCIL has applied to the **C.R.B.** for funds for roadwork totalling £285,000. This covers all headings under which money is granted.

The list includes £62,000 worth of fresh works on unclassified roads, for which the Council set a priority, federal and patrol maintenance £36,000 and fresh works on various C.R.B. roads in the shire under the heading of maintenance.

The £62,000 is made up mainly of roads which are urgently in need of major attention or reconstruction.

1. Patch Road from Kallista to Cook's corner;
2. Rice's Road, Emerald;
3. Scoresby Road from the railway line to Wantirna-Sassafras Road;
4. Bergin's Road from Stud to Gearon's Road;

5. High Street, bridge;
6. Sassafras Creek Road, from The Crescent to Kallista;
7. Bayswater to Olinda Rd. from Forest Road to the Shire boundary;
8. Duffy's, Dawson's Road, etc. in South Riding;
9. Sherbrooke Road, from Kallista to Marybrooke;
10. Bayswater-Croydon Rd., Dandenong Creek bridge;
11. Collier Avenue, Upwey;
12. Morris Road, from Ternes Road to Griffiths Rd.;
13. Old Belgrave Road from U.F.T.G. to Upwey;
14. Traey's Road, Emerald;
15. O'Meagher Road, Macclesfield;
16. School Road, Menzies Creek, past Walker's property;
17. Glenfern Road.

Last year, Council applied for about £270,000 from the C.R.B. and got only a fraction of that amount.

A great deal of the money sought this year is for work for which unsuccessful application was made last year.

The real problem of the council is not in applying for the money but in deciding what to do when they don't get it.

Details of the requests for each road will be published next week.
