

Similarly, the first selectors in Bayswater secured titles in 1867,
 and
 amongst them Hugh Rourke, who added to his P.R. holding; Wm. Gerleich (Gerlach).
 G. Tillack and (probably) Martin Kleinert between present Mtn. Hway and
 Boronia Road. The following year Diedrich Sasse~~g~~ took up land on Scoresby
 Road while Henry Doherty selected an area on Mountain Highway.

The first selectors in present Boronia came to the district in 1867,
 Geo. Wilkes taking up a small area near the Blind Creek and Geo. Doherty
 another on present Boronia Road. At the same period Wilkes also selected
 a substantial holding around Commercial Road, Fern Tree Gully while
 279 acs. $\frac{1}{3}$
 Enoch Chambers took up ~~subdividing~~ in the Parish of Narree Worran, location unknown.
