Wm. Murphy, one of the earliest settlers, hailed from Tipperary,

Ireland, while his 20-year-old wife, Jane McCaughan Murphy was born in

County Antrim. The couple first settled at St. Kilds but during the 70's

made their home at "Mt. Erin" in the hills and it is a point of interest

that their selection originally included the present One Tree Hill Reserve,

later resumed by the Crown in exchange for other land. Wm. Murphy was

captured captured as a Crown Lands Bailiff and received the princely

sum of El per week (including the keep of a horse) for patrolling an erea

extending as far as Kalorama. Due to his frequent resummental absence,

Mrs Murphy was compelled to play a major part in managing the farm and
