It will be seen from the foregoing that a reduction of 20,000 acres in the size of the forest took place over a period of 30 years from 1867, although 556 acres of this area became the National Park at Upper Fern Tree Gully. It is therefore particularly interesting to note that during 48 years' administration by the Forests Commission of Victoria commoder no land has been alienated from the Grown, the net reduction of 1,378 acres which has taken place during that period being reservation of land for road, recreation or for or other Bublic Burposes.
