

Re revocation of 16th July 1877 (Your letter  
25th November, 1953.)

This area is almost certainly Crown Allotment 63E, R. W. Carrick, on the south side of the narrow gauge crossing at Upper Gully. It is shown on Scoresby Parish Plan and also enlarged in the right margin. In case you cannot locate it, I enclose a small tracing.

I have not received a copy of the Government Gazette giving proclamation of the Berwick Roads District 1862. Would you be good enough to send me a copy.
